Welcome to the Brandon Valley School District. Brandon Valley School District 49-2 was originated in 1962 reorganizing with the Valley Springs School District, Brandon School District and twelve common school districts creating one district. The district encompasses 128 square miles bordering Sioux Falls to the west, Minnesota and Iowa to the east, Canton to the south and Garretson to the north.

Our district has grown from 900 students in 1962 to nearly 5,000 students today making it the fourth largest school district in South Dakota. The three districts larger than Brandon Valley include Sioux Falls, Rapid City, and Harrisburg.

Our district has a high school (grades 9-12), middle school (grades 7-8), intermediate school (grades 5-6) and five elementary schools (grades JrK-4) with one elementary school in Valley Springs, two elementary schools in Brandon, and two elementary schools in the city limits of Sioux Falls. Brandon Valley School District 49-2 is fortunate to be one of the few districts in the state of South Dakota that is enjoying growth in numbers of students and taxable valuation. The district employs nearly 550 staff. This includes 280 teaching staff, 250 classified staff and 16 administrators. There are more than 2,000 students bused daily. Busing is provided to in-town students Grades Jr.K-12 for a nominal fee.

Students have a full range of extracurricular choices in athletics, music, speech, and drama, and Brandon Valley is well known around the state and region for our excellence in both athletics and fine art activities. Athletic opportunities include football, basketball, wrestling, track, soccer, volleyball, cross country, golf, tennis, bowling, softball, baseball, soccer, cheer and dance, and student manager/trainer. The High School Band program continually receives top ratings in all competitions. The completion of the Brandon Valley Performing Arts Center has brought the drama program performances to a superior level. Spring musicals sell out four performances on a single weekend. Students are also involved in the inner workings of the behind-the-scenes lighting and sound equipment during various student performances. The "PAC" is an extraordinary asset to students *and* the community to promote the fine arts. Brandon Valley has a full range of programs addressing the wide variety of learning needs of its students. In addition, students in the HS have many choices of Advanced Placement and college credit-bearing courses that prepare them for their future college experiences.

Brandon Valley prides itself in our professional staff and strong viable curriculum that prepares students for the future. Brandon Valley School District 49-2 will continue to grow and keep pace with the requirements to meet every student's needs. 

Brandon Valley High School is a grades 9-12 state-accredited school serving more than 1,300 students. The school provides a comprehensive curriculum meeting the needs of an academically diverse student population. Students' classroom experiences are enhanced by a wide array of extra-curricular activities. Each year approximately 75 percent of our graduating seniors go on to some form of higher education with an additional 4% entering the military. Traditionally, over 60 percent of our students participate in one or more extra-curricular activities.

The staff averages over 17 years of teaching experience with over half holding master's degrees. The commitment of the staff, efforts of the students, and the support of the people in our communities have allowed BVHS to build a reputation as one of the strongest academic high schools in South Dakota. Based on state and national test results, BVHS consistently ranks as one of South Dakota's top performing Class AA high schools.

Brandon Valley High School was originally constructed in 1967 with major additions/renovations occurring in 1974, 1999, 2002, 2005, 2008, 2009, 2010 and 2016. We will break ground on our newest addition in June of 2022 with completion targeted for the 2023-24 school year. Our students have access to some of the finest facilities in the region. In addition, Brandon Valley High School is a one-to-one school with all high school students being issued a MacBook Air laptop.

The state-of-the-art 800 seat theater/auditorium complex is used by students throughout the district for various fine-arts performances, along with numerous community events/performances. The joint city/county/school provides our students and the public with access to a wide range of materials and technology. 





