

Student Responsibility Period (SRP)

The academic school day ends at 3:20 for all students. A student may earn a 3:00pm dismissal by maintaining all grades at a D or above in each of their classes for the grading period (midterm, quarter, semester). When a student earns a D- or below in an academic class in a specific grading period, the student will be placed in an assigned SRP class which runs from 3:00-3:20 each day. Attendance in SRP is required. Failure to report to the SRP will result in Saturday School points and possible suspension, as with any other period throughout the day. Additionally, semester test exemption status may be impacted by unexcused SRP absences and tardies.

The purpose of the SRP is to provide structured remediation or academic support for students within the school day under the supervision of a BVHS staff member. Students remain in SRP for the duration of the grading period. All freshmen begin the year with an SRP placement to provide additional academic support to start the year.

A student's employment will not be considered as a valid absence from SRP. Students are required to work with their employers to accommodate the academic school day that ends at 3:20.
