Qualifications Information and Criteria

The Booster Club will award at least seventeen male or female Scholarships. The top male and the top female candidate will each be the recipient of the \$1,000.00 Brandon Valley Booster Club - Pat Van Whye Memorial Scholarship Award. The runner-up male and female candidate will each be the recipient of a \$750.00 Scholarship Award. The remaining winners will each receive a \$500.00 Scholarship Award.

Eligible candidates must have participated in athletics as an athlete, manager or trainer during his/her senior year and completed the entire season.

Eligible candidates must be attending a post-secondary school in the fall following graduation.

Voting Procedures

Booster Club Board Members are encouraged to vote for candidates they believe have demonstrated positive athletic and citizenship representation of the Brandon and Valley Springs communities.

Scholarship Applications are available through the Athletic Director.

Absentee Voting: A Booster Club Board Member who is unable to attend the meeting when candidates will be selected may vote absentee at the school office prior the April Booster Club meeting. At the school office you may view the folder of all applicants and cast your vote. Place your finished form in an envelope, seal it shut and leave it in the folder. Cross your name off the list to indicate you have voted. No votes may be cast

Voting Procedure: Each scholarship application will be posted on the wall and reviewed by every Booster Club Board Member who casts a vote. The physical posting and voting will occur during the April Booster Club meeting. The Scholarship Committee, or designee, will count the ballots to determine the popular vote factor of the selection formula based on percentage of male and female applications. The top two scholarship levels will be awarded to a male and a female regardless of proportion of applicants. The last available scholarships will be awarded based on proportion of applicants between male and female with at least one of each gender receiving a scholarship at this level.

The scholarship formula will be applied to all applications to determine the scholarship winners and their respective values.

If applicants are still tied after the formula is applied, original Board Member general vote will be tie-breaker.
