What do students need to do? Link to BV instructional video for week of April 20-24, 2020	<p>Let's Celebrate EARTH DAY!</p> <p>Monday 4/20: Birdhouse Challenge - create a bird shelter out of recyclables (examples include a shoe box, milk jug, or pop bottle). Your house must include a perch and an opening for the bird. Be creative. If you want to, take a picture of your birdhouse, and send it to your teacher!</p> <p>Tuesday 4/21: List the items you used in the birdhouse challenge that are recyclable.</p> <p>Wednesday 4/22: Write 3-5 sentences telling why or how recycling is important to our earth.</p> <p>Thursday 4/23: Go for a walk. Pick up garbage to help our earth.</p> <p>Friday 4/24: Check over your recycling writing assignment for any incomplete sentences or grammar and punctuation issues and make revisions before you turn in your assignment to your teacher.</p>
