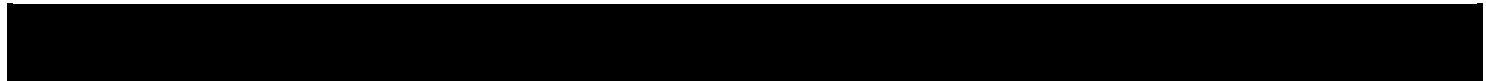

What do students need to do? Link to BV instructional video for week of April 6-10, 2020	Monday (4/6): <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Practice ABAB patterns with 2 different kinds of toys, for example car block car block, or doll ball doll ball Tuesday (4/7): <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Write 2 sets of numbers 1-10 of pieces of paper (or a deck of cards or uno numbers) and play memory- practice matching the numbers Wednesday (4/8): <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Go outside and look for objects of each basic color- red, orange, yellow, green, blue, purple, black, brown, white Thursday (4/9): <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Walk around your home and count the number of chairs Friday (4/10): No school <ul style="list-style-type: none"> No assignment

<p>What do students need to do?</p> <p>Link to BV instructional video for week of April 6-10, 2020</p>	<p>Monday (4/6):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Read 10 minutes ● Mystery Box! Write letters of the ABCs or your child’s name on pieces of paper and put the letters in a bag, cup, or box, etc. and have the student pick out a letter and say it <p>Tuesday (4/7):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Read 10 minutes ● Write your child’s name on a piece of paper, have them say each letter then decorate it with colors, stickers, etc. <p>Wednesday (4/8):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Read 10 minutes ● Write the letters of the ABCs or your child’s name on pieces of paper and scatter them on the floor. Call out a letter and have your child use a fly swatter or a spatula to “swat” that letter <p>Thursday (4/9):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Read 10 minutes ● Have your child pick a toy and have them put it on, under, beside, above, behind, and in front of the table, between 2 objects <p>Friday (4/10): No School</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● No assignment

What do students need to do? Link to BV instructional video for week of April 6-10, 2020	Monday (4/6): <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Cut or tear paper and make a collage Tuesday (4/7): <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Write or draw shapes, letters, numbers, name, etc. in salt, sugar or shaving cream. Wednesday (4/8): <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Write your child's name in all uppercase letters and have them trace it multiple times in different colors, types of writing utensils, etc. Thursday (4/9): <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Write your child's name on a large paper, you cut it into multiple pieces and have your child put it back together like a puzzle Friday (4/10): No school <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● No assignment
