Draw a large figure 8 on a chalkboard, piece of paper, or with chalk on the sidewalk, have your child stand/sit in the middle of the figure 8, and then ask him or her to trace the shape using his or her finger, a pencil, a piece of chalk, etc. using his or her dominant hand. The shape of the figure 8 will force him or her to cross the midline while tracing, making this one of the easiest crossing the midline exercises for kids! You can make this extra fun by using shaving cream and a cookie tray if you want to add a sensory component to this activity.
