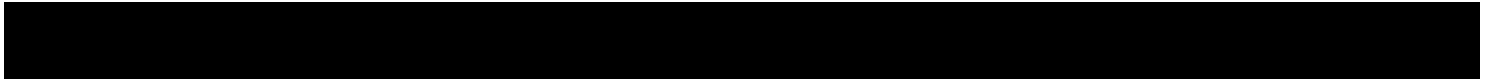

Mount Rushmore project:

Based on your prior knowledge from what we have covered so far this year, you will be creating your own Mount Rushmore. Think about all the people that we have covered so far this year that you could include. **You will need to include 4 influential people that in your opinion should be included on Mount Rushmore.**

Examples of people you could include: Sitting Bull, Geronimo, Christopher Columbus, John Cabot, Juan Ponce de Leon, George Washington, Benjamin Franklin, Thomas Jefferson, John Adams, John Hancock, Samuel Adams, Meriwether Lewis, William Clark, Sacajawea, etc...

If available, you may do your own research on any others!

DAY ONE--- Monday

- Choose your first person to put on your Mount Rushmore.
- Sketch out a face of your person in the first column on your paper. Include their name.
- Then write a paragraph stating why you think that they deserve to be part of Mount Rushmore in your opinion.
- SEE EXAMPLE to see how this project should be set up and completed.

DAY TWO --- Tuesday

- Choose your second person to put on your Mount Rushmore.
- Sketch out a face of your person in the second column on your paper. Include their name.
- Then write a paragraph stating why you think that they deserve to be part of Mount Rushmore in your opinion.
- SEE EXAMPLE, as needed.

DAY THREE – Wednesday

- Choose your third person to put on your Mount Rushmore.
- Sketch out a face of your person in the third column on your paper. Include their name.
- Then write a paragraph stating why you think that they deserve to be part of Mount Rushmore in your opinion.
- SEE EXAMPLE, as needed.

DAY FOUR -- Thursday

- Choose your fourth person to put on your Mount Rushmore.
- Sketch out a face of your person in the fourth column on your paper. Include their name.
- Then write a paragraph stating why you think that they deserve to be part of Mount Rushmore in your opinion.
