What do students need to do?	<p>Monday (3/16):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Draw a picture and write an equation for this problem. "I see four leprechauns in a field. Five more come to play. How many are there in all?"</li> </ul> <p>Tuesday (3/17):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Draw and cut out 10 shamrocks. Use them to show different ways to make 10. Write the equations for each way to make 10.</li> </ul> <p>Wednesday (3/18):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Ask a grown up for pennies, nickels, or dimes. Practice counting by ones, fives, or tens.</li> </ul> <p>Thursday (3/19):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Go on a rainbow food hunt at home. Make tallies for how many foods of each color you find!</li> </ul>
What do students need to bring back when school resumes?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Paper with their picture and written equations for additions problems.</li> <li>• Paper with equations for each way to make 10.</li> </ul>
What standards do the lessons cover?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• K.CC.1 Count to 100 by ones and by tens.</li> <li>• K.OA.1 Represent addition and subtraction with objects, fingers, mental images, drawings, sounds, etc...</li> <li>• K.OA.2 Solve addition and subtraction word problems.</li> </ul>
