(Answer is). -sit. Take away the beginning /s/ sound. (Answer it). -dog. Change /d/ to /f/ sound. (Answer fog). -rat. Change /r/ to /p/ sound. (Answer pat). -some. Change the /g/ to an /l/. (Answer pat). -some. Change the /g/ to an /l/. (Answer pan). -meat. Take away the ending sound /t/. (Answer me). Wednesday (3/25): Write the capital and lowercase letters in the alphabet. Say the sounds to your family when you are done. Thursday (3/26): Draw a big rainbow. Use the colors of the rainbow to write these sight words: -That -Do -Here -Go From -What -Said -Was -What -Said -Was
	Friday (3/27): Read or listen to any picture book at your house. Tell your family what happened at the beginning, middle, and ending of the story. Make a prediction at what you think could happen next.
