Write the numbers 11-20. Draw that many circles next to the number. ● Practice your telephone number. <p>Tuesday (3/31)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● 2-Dimensional Shapes. Draw a circle, square, rectangle, triangle, and hexagon. Write how many sides and vertices each shape has. ● Count as high as you can. <p>Wednesday (4/1)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Draw and cut out 9 hearts. Use them to show different ways to make 9. Write the equations for each way to make 9. ● Count by 5's to 100. <p>Thursday (4/2)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● There are 6 big frogs playing in the pond. 3 small frogs join them. Draw a picture and write an equation to show your answer. ● A frog ate 2 flies. Then he ate 5 more flies. How many did the frog eat in all? Draw a picture and write an equation <p>Friday (4/3)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Tell a family member the days of the week and months of the year. ● Write the number that comes before and after the number given. <p>Ex: <u> </u>13<u> </u> you would write 12 before 13, 14 after 13.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"> <u> </u>18<u> </u> <u> </u>10<u> </u> <u> </u>17<u> </u> <u> </u>19<u> </u> <u> </u>11<u> </u> <u> </u>13<u> </u> <u> </u>15<u> </u> <u> </u>16<u> </u> </p>
