Link to BV instructional video for week of May 4-8, 2020	Monday (5/4): <ul style="list-style-type: none">● Gather 10 toys and sort them by color Tuesday (5/5): <ul style="list-style-type: none">● Use craft sticks to build different shapes- triangle, rectangle, square, diamond, etc. Wednesday (5/6): <ul style="list-style-type: none">● Blow bubbles and count how many are floating Thursday (5/7): <ul style="list-style-type: none">● Use a pipe cleaner to measure different objects in your home- for example how many pipe cleaners tall is the kitchen table Friday (5/8): <ul style="list-style-type: none">● No assignment

<p>What do students need to do?</p> <p><u>Link to BV instructional video for week of May 4-8, 2020</u></p>	<p>Monday (5/4):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Read 10 minutes • Practice naming and writing the letters in your name <p>Tuesday (5/5):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Read 10 minutes • Go on a letter hunt- find all of the letters of your name around your home <p>Wednesday (5/6):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Read 10 minutes • After reading a book, have your child draw a picture about the story and try retelling the story <p>Thursday (5/7):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Read 10 minutes • Alphabet monster- write letters on small papers, “feed the monster” by putting the letters in the bag, say each letter as you feed them <p>Friday (5/8):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No assignment

<p>What do students need to do?</p> <p><u>Link to BV instructional video for week of May 4-8, 2020</u></p>	<p>Monday (5/4):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> String dry noodles on pipe cleaners <p>Tuesday (5/5):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Fold a straw in half to use as tongs, practice picking up cotton balls <p>Wednesday (5/6):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Toilet paper roll haircuts, cut strips in the top of a toilet paper roll, have your child practice cutting off the strips (see notes) <p>Thursday (5/7):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Use an empty spice container with holes and put spaghetti noodles in each hole <p>Friday (5/8):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> No assignment
