- PLAY! Find 2 sticks or something similar to tap the beat. You can use forks, wooden spoons, and even bananas! Practice tapping the steady beat to the music.

- TREASURE HUNT! What is the difference between steady beat and no beat? A steady beat will repeat just as before - steady and even. How many sounds around you can you think of that have a steady beat? (Hint: dripping water, clock ticking, microwave timer, person walking) Find 5 sounds WITH a steady beat, and 5 WITHOUT. Make a list on a sheet of paper. Take a picture & submit to Seesaw!

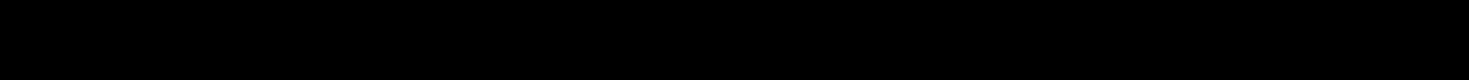
Thursday):
