## Scissors, Scissors


(I'm a Little Teapot)


Scissors, scissors, they're used to cut. It's very easy, just open and shut! They ONLY cut paper, definitely not hair.




They don't cut our friends, or the clothes that we wear! We only walk with scissors, so that we are safe.

We never run or throw them, and we put them in their place.









# Crayons




