Monday (11/23): Science and Math

- K.LS1.1** Watch the Mystery Science Lesson: Why do people eat turkey on Thanksgiving? (The link can be found in your Handouts.) Answer the following question- What kind of food do you eat on Thanksgiving day?
- K.G.B.5** Turkey Glyph! We are going to be making a Turkey Glyph Shelf Sitter. Use the instructions in the handouts to complete the craft. After completing the craft, fill out “My Turkey Glyph Book” in the handouts.
- Answer the following question- What shapes did you use to create your Turkey Shelf Sitter?

Tuesday (11/24): Reading & STEM

- Watch the Week at a Glance Video for Tuesday!
- K-2-ETS1-2.** Engineering/STEM- Yesterday we learned why people eat turkey on Thanksgiving and you thought of different foods that you like to eat on Thanksgiving. Today we are going to build a table to hold our Thanksgiving meal. Think of the table you eat at on a daily basis or specifically, on Thanksgiving. Is it round? Square? Big? Small? In your handouts, you will find a page labeled “Dinner Table Challenge.”
 - Your goal is to build a table big enough to hold all of the food, without overlapping. Use materials from around your house to create your table! It needs to be sturdy enough to hold the cutout food from the handout and the food cannot overlap. If your table is not sturdy, too big, or too small, modify your design.
 - Once you have built a sturdy table that can hold all the food cutouts without overlapping, select items to represent chairs and determine if your entire family could sit at your table. If you don't have enough room, how could you modify your design so everyone could sit at the table?
- K.W.2** Reading/Writing- Thanksgiving Turkey! Read or listen to ‘Llama Llama Gives Thanks.’ After reading, think of what you are thankful for. Complete the Thanksgiving Turkey-Writing Activity in the handouts. Allow your kindergarten student to practice creating the words out on their own.
