



	 Growth Mindset- Look at the difference between growth and fixed mindset. Fixed mindset sees it as if you are smart or not. You have a fixed level of intelligence. Growth mindset sees that your brain is like a muscle and the more you use it, the stronger and smarter you can become. Challenge your child to keep trying when learning new things even if they might make a mistake. See mistakes as part of the learning process.
