In negotiations, this objective may be best attained when there is a climate of mutual trust and understanding between the negotiating parties.

The Board believes that the best interests of public education will be served by establishing procedures that provide an orderly method for the Board and representatives of the staff to discuss matters of common concern.

It is further recognized that nothing in negotiations may compromise the Board's legal responsibilities, nor may any employee's statutory rights and privileges be impaired.
