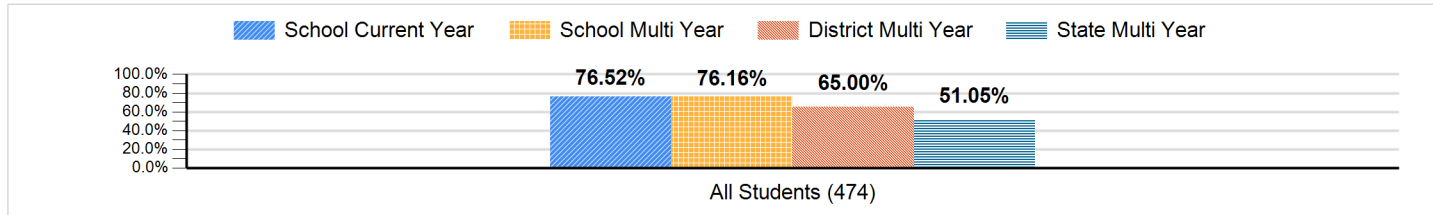
Student Population

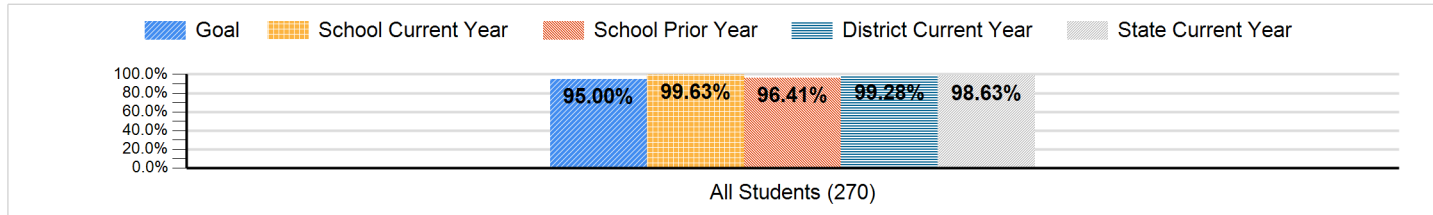

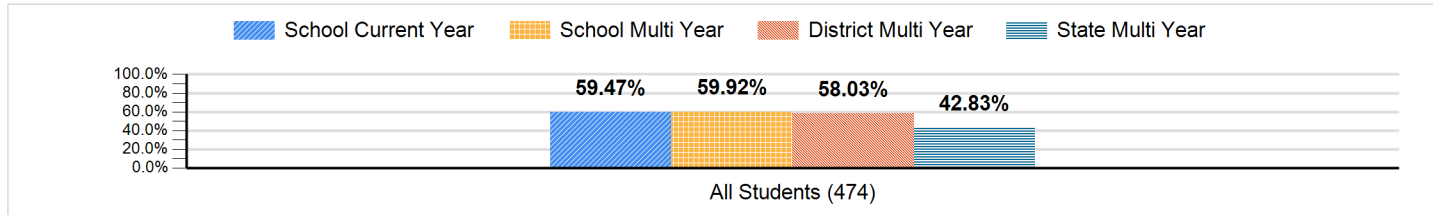

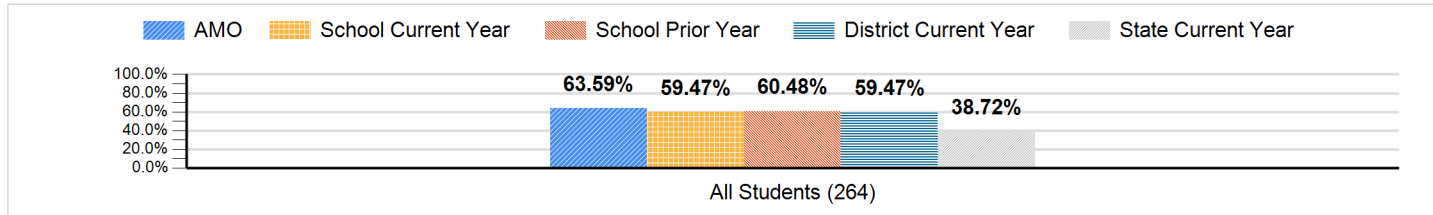

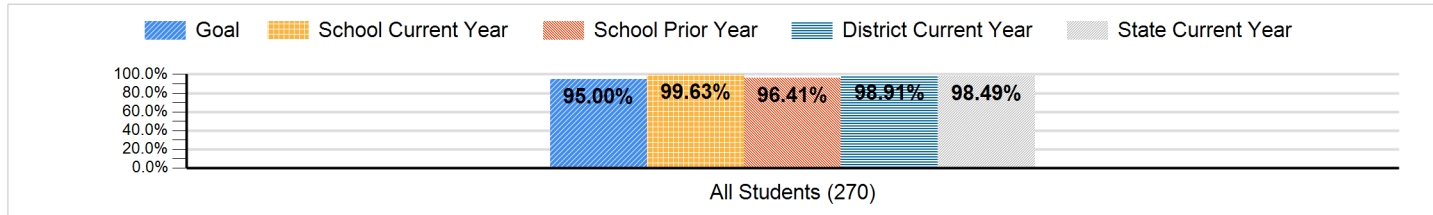

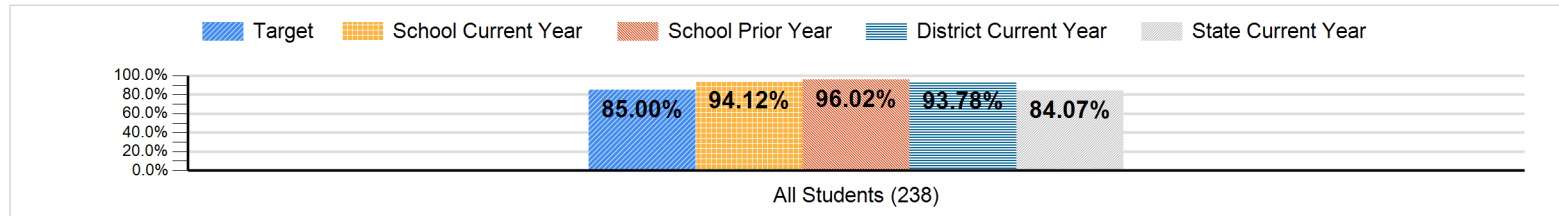

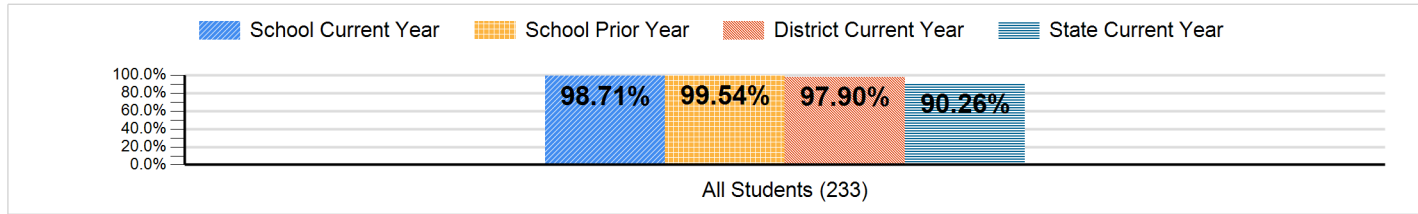

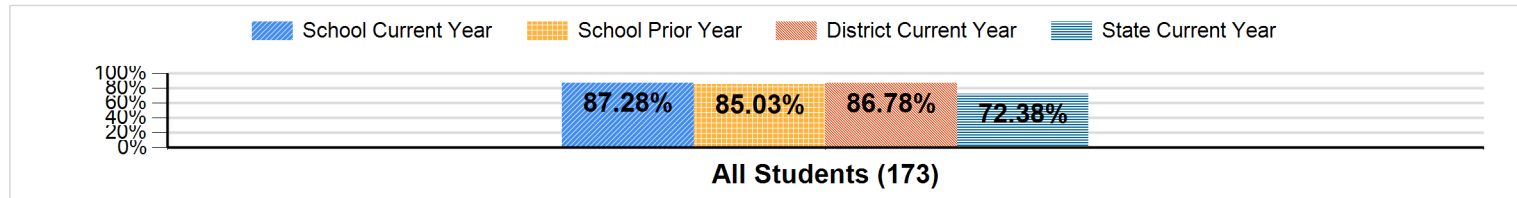
