Planning is under way for the Brandon Valley Community Health Fair! There are new activities, events and exhibits being planned! A few of the highlights include:

Sanford Health's MEGA heart exhibit – An inflatable, walk-through heart that allows you to explore the heart, learn about cardiovascular functions and observe examples of various types of heart disease.

Heart Screenings – Blood Pressure, Cholesterol check, BMI, Framingham, EKG, and a CT (calcium score). Results provided that day except for the EKG (must be read by a physician). Cost of screening is \$50. Participants must schedule their screening. More information to come.
